### System information

### How to use the service

- It's just like logging on at Starbucks or in a hotel!
- Turn on your computer. All you need to connect is a wireless card or external antenna for your computer.
- Look for the wireless indicator in your tray (bottom right corner of the screen usually). You may need to **Enable** your wireless access.
- Launch Internet Explorer.
- The sign up screen will open.
- Choose your period of service and pay using a credit card.
- You're on!

### Signal quality

Your signal quality depends on how close you are to a repeater and whether you have windows facing the signal source. The signal cannot penetrate concrete block walls. If you are having signal issues, please see below for your options.

The service is provided via a high speed bridge and repeaters. It works great for web surfing, e-mail, instant messaging, file downloads and small business use. The broadband provider monitors usage under the fair usage policy; it will cut off service for excess use. Unfortunately there is no notice. The cut off period is generally 24 or 48 hours.

If your signal is not strong enough for good service, you have several options:

1. The cheapest option is to try an external antenna. These plug into your computer's CAT5 cable port. If you can arrange to use the computer near a window with line of sight to a repeater, this may be all you need. Darryl Poturalski keeps a few of these for sale.

2. The solution most people choose is having a rooftop antenna installed. The computer connects to the cable from the antenna. See [www.rockypointwifi.com/pricing.pdf](http://www.rockypointwifi.com/pricing.pdf) for the total cost of the equipment and installation.

3. With wireless access inside the house, you will be able to use the computer in different areas. To get wireless access, you need to have a wireless router installed. See [www.rockypointwifi.com/pricing.pdf](http://www.rockypointwifi.com/pricing.pdf) for the cost of the wireless router.

### Connecting details

If your computer is already set up for wireless access, connecting is really simple - just click on your usual icon for logging onto a wireless service. This automatically takes you to our ISP (Internet Service Provider). Clicking on your Internet icon may also get you there if a wireless connection is already enabled. Until you pay for service with PayPal or a credit card, when you try to access the Internet, you can only connect to the payment page. After you sign up/pay for service, you can go anywhere on the Internet you want. If you've signed up for more than a single use, the next time you connect during the service period, the "payment page" is automatically by-passed and you can go right to whatever Internet page you want. For the techies, the service automatically recognizes your computer's MAC address to determine your payment status.

It is also a good idea to record your login and password. If there is a power outage or the system is down for any other reason, your automatic recognition may be lost.

**If you've never connected wirelessly, locate and test your wireless settings before you come to the beach!**
